Target	Actions	Impact
To give every child in our school a chance to pray at home.	 With help from Mrs Smith, Liturgy Leaders will make a Prayer Bag for every class. Liturgy Leaders will change the Prayer Bag every time the Liturgical Season changes to make sure all of the items in there are relevant and purposeful. Liturgy Leaders will present the Prayer Bags to each class in Gospel Assembly and speak about how to use them at home. Class Teachers to make sure every child in the class gets a turn at taking the Prayer Bag home. Liturgy Leaders to check and monitor the Prayer Bags in case any items need replacing. 	Children will have the resources they need to help them know how to pray at home. Children at SFX will share meaningful prayer times with their family at home. All children in our school community at SFX will deepen their relationship with God. All children will feel closer to God and know that they can talk to him through prayer at any time.
All of the class Prayer Tables and Prayer areas around the school will reflect the correct Liturgical Season and be a good focus point for Prayer.	 Liturgy Leaders will change their class Prayer Tables and communal Prayer areas around the school to reflect the Liturgical Season and special celebrations. Liturgy Leaders to monitor the Prayer areas around the school to check they match the liturgical season; check they are purposeful and that they are not cluttered. Liturgy Leaders to help set up for assemblies, prayer services and tidy away after. Liturgy Leaders to distribute and collect prayer cloths to classes when the liturgical season changes. Liturgy Leaders to set up a prayer basket on all Prayer Tables for children, staff and parent prayer intentions. 	Children and staff will use the prayer areas around the school and in classrooms as a focal point for daily prayer. Children will understand the liturgical seasons and the meaning of the colour by which they are represented. Children will stop and pray more spontaneously. Children and staff will have opportunities to offer their own prayer intentions.
To give children opportunities for spontaneous prayer within the school day and environment.	 Liturgy Leaders will open a quiet prayer area in the Nest that all children can access at break and lunch times. On a rota, the Liturgy Leaders will lead weekly prayer sessions at lunch times for any child to attend. Liturgy Leaders to notify all classes/children of prayer opportunities available during break and lunch times. 	Children will want to pray and be able to pray whenever they want to. Children will learn new scripture and understand it. They will have a greater understanding of God's message. Children will be able to develop their own spiritual faith formation, deepening their relationship with God.
To make sure all of the children in our school have a better understanding of our faith and Scripture.	Liturgy Leaders will hold a Bible Quiz once every month.	The children in our school will have a better understanding of scripture. The children will understand the messages from the Bible and use these to help them learn how to live out their faith.
