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
T: The story of Joshua entering the promised land.

How did Moses persuade the Pharaoh to free the Israelites?


How did Moses help the Israelites to cross the Red Sea?

Even though the Hebrews were free, they were still in the desert. They wanted to find a land called Canaan which God had promised them.

The journey was very long and they soon ran out of food. They were hungry and blamed Moses for taking them out of Egypt. Moses told them that God would provide food.



Moses had led God's people for many years. God had promised them a wonderful land, but this did not happen straight away. The trip from Egypt to the promised land should have taken the Israelites only days, but they wandered the desert for forty years.



By this time, Moses was over a hundred years old. It was decided that a man named Joshua would become the new leader of the Israelites.

God said to Joshua:

“I will be with you, just as I was with Moses. I will never leave you. I will never desert you. Be strong and brave. You will lead these people, and they will take the land as their very own. It is the land I promised with an oath to give their people long ago. Be strong and very brave. Make sure you obey the whole law my servant Moses gave you. Do not turn away from it to the right or the left. Then you will have success everywhere you go. Never stop reading this Scroll of the Law. Day and night you must think about what it says. Make sure you do everything that is written in it. Then things will go well with you. And you will have great success.

“Here is what I am commanding you to do. Be strong and brave. Do not be terrified. Do not lose hope. I am the Lord your God. I will be with you everywhere you go.”
